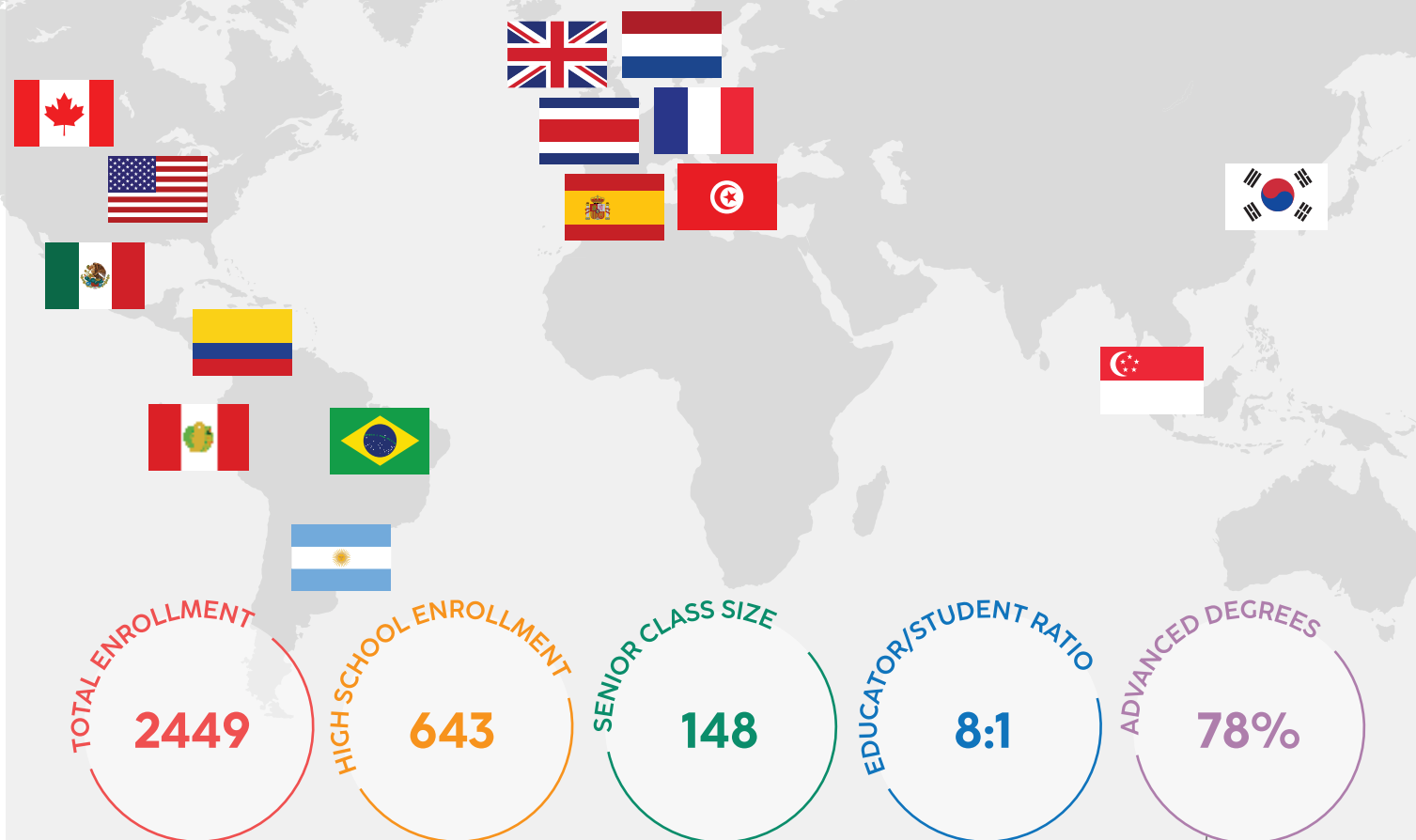

ACADEMIC PROGRAM OVERVIEW

All ASFM courses are instructed in English except courses designated for the Mexican Bachillerato or additional language courses. ASFM provides three diploma pathways: a United States high school diploma, the Mexican Bachillerato, and the Advanced Placement Capstone Diploma. The US diploma pathway is aligned with US educational standards. The Mexican Bachillerato is aligned with the expectations outlined by the Secretaria de Educacion of Nuevo Leon.

ASFM GRADING SCALE

ASFM utilizes a competency-based approach to grading. Students must demonstrate minimum competency in each course to earn a passing grade. ASFM reports grades on a four-point scale.

4.0 to 3.7	COMPLEX UNDERSTANDING	The student demonstrates the expected knowledge and skills and is able to transfer their knowledge to demonstrate a conceptual understanding beyond the course context.
3.69 to 3.4	CONNECTED UNDERSTANDING	The student demonstrates the expected knowledge and skills and is able to make conceptual connections within the course context.
3.39 to 3.0	COMPETENT UNDERSTANDING	The student demonstrates the expected knowledge and skills and is able to use what they have learned within the course context.
Below 3.0	NOT PASSING	The student failed to demonstrate the expected knowledge and skills within the course context.

ASFM adds an additional grade weight of 1.2 for Advanced Placement courses and 1.1 for honors courses. ASFM does not rank students and is not able to provide class rank.

STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED to complete 100 hours of community service PRIOR TO GRADUATION.

INTERNATIONAL TESTING RESTRICTIONS

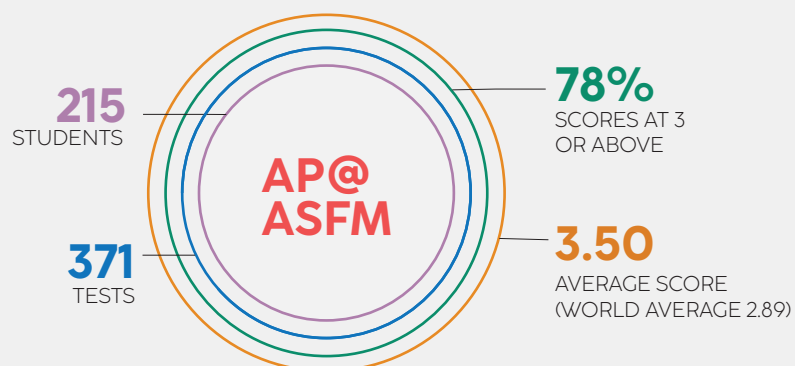
ASFM resumed SAT test sessions in January 2022. As a result, the school is not providing the SAT results for the Class of 2023.

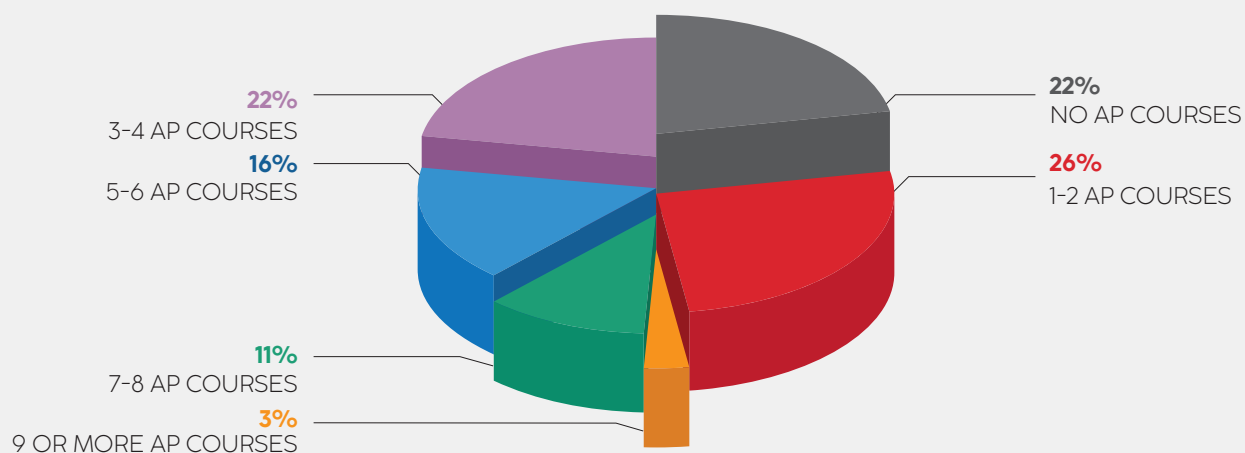

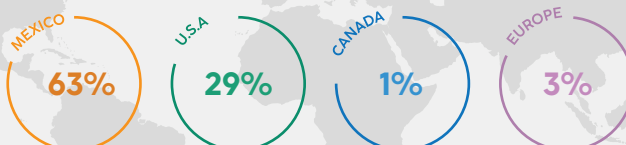
