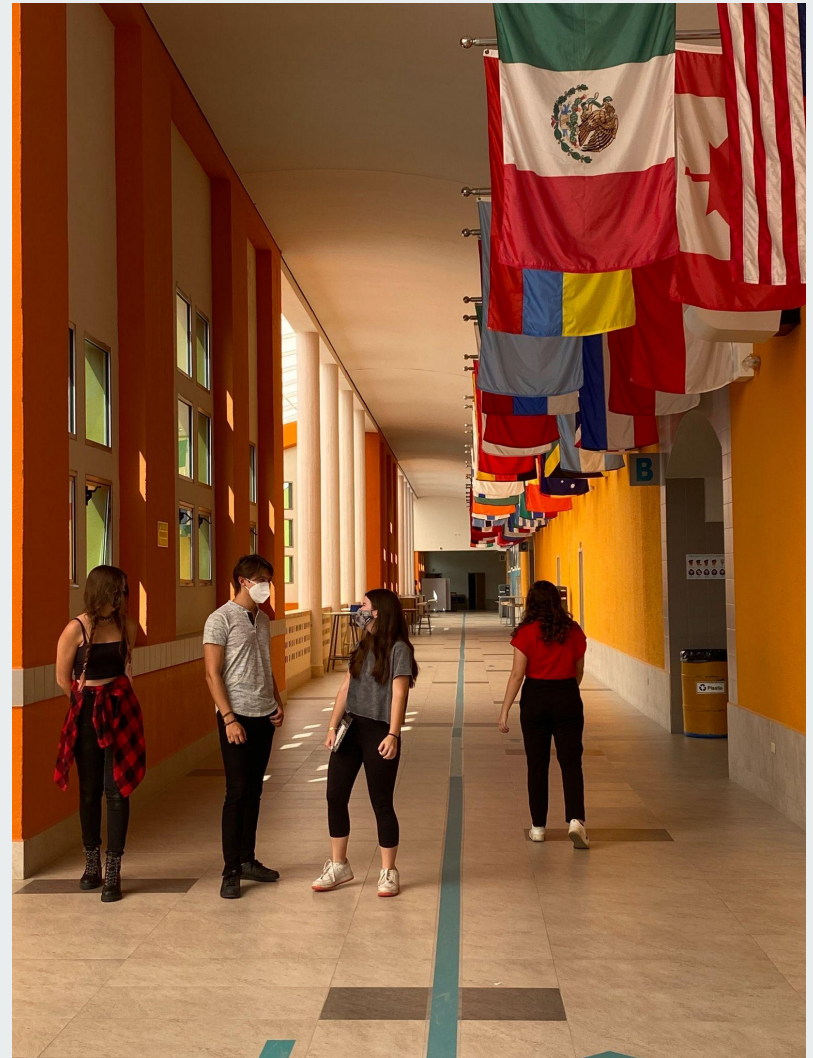

- ✓ First year reported in the HS Transcript
- ✓ End of Semester projects or exams
- ✓ Students are responsible to stay up to date (via Unified Classroom, school email, Google Chat)
- ✓ Students are responsible for absences and catching up on missing work

# Study Hall and PLT



- ✓ Study Hall is an independent time for students to work on their assignments during the school day
- ✓ PLT is a time in the schedule where teachers are available and may require a student to attend.
  - Student may seek support from teachers during this time.
  - If your child receives an email invitation from a teacher, PLT is MANDATORY for that class until dismissed by the teacher.

# Absences & Tardies



- ✓ Parent (legal guardian) inform the Attendance Account ([attendance.mshs@asfm.edu.mx](mailto:attendance.mshs@asfm.edu.mx)) 5 days prior so students have an opportunity to check with their teachers prior to the absences
- ✓ Student should inform each teacher and ask for assignments
- ✓ It is the student's responsibility to ensure that attendance record is correct.

# Whenever your child is absent:



1. Check the [G9 Learning Planner](#) where student will find all the information on how to contact teachers' class pages and contact information.
2. Student emails teachers to set up a meeting during PLT time (Monday to Thursday from 2:45 - 3:45 p.m.) and attending Monday's Distance Learning classes to clarify any questions you may have.
3. Student or parent may contact G9 Counselor ([Ms. Tiquet](#)) as needed for any assistance organizing weekly work.

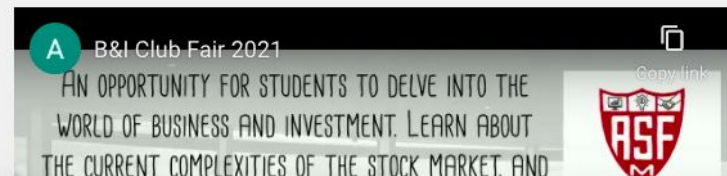
